

# WHY BE BAPTIZED?



"All authority has been given unto Me in heaven and on earth. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations,

BAPTIZING them in the name

of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you.

### **Understanding BAPTISM**

#### Who Should Be BAPTIZED?

- Believers. In the New Testament, no one was ever BAPTIZED until after they had trusted Jesus Christ as Savior.
- The Biblical example of baptism is a "Believer's BAPTISM."
  (Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 2:41; Acts 8:12-13; Acts 8:35-38; Acts 10:44-48; Acts 16:14-15; Acts 18:8; 1 Corinthians 1:10-18)

#### What Does **BAPTISM** Picture?

- BAPTISM symbolizes the Believer's Death, Burial, and Resurrection with Jesus Christ (Romans 6:3-4; Colossians 2:12).
- BAPTISM is an outward picture of what God did for us spiritually the moment we were saved. He identified us with Jesus Christ!

### Why Should Believers Be Must I Be <u>BAPTIZED</u>?

 Jesus Christ was BAPTIZED (Matthew 3:13-17).

**BAPTIZED?** 

- BAPTISM is commanded in the Bible (Matthew 28:19-20; Acts 10:48).
- All New Testament believers were.
- BAPTISM is the God-ordained public testimony of being a follower of Jesus Christ.

## Must I be BAPTIZED to be saved? No. (Ephesians 2:8-9; Titus 3:5)

 Must I be BAPTIZED to be obedient? Yes. (Matthew 28:19-20; Acts 10:48)

#### **How Should We Be BAPTIZED?**

- The language about BAPTISM in the New Testament implies immersion. (John 3:23; Acts 8:38-39; Matthew 3:16: Mark 1:9-10).
- The meaning of the word BAPTIZO demands immersion. This Greek word meant "to dip, plunge, or immerse."
- The symbolism of BAPTISM demands immersion. (See Romans 6:3-5)

#### What Follows BAPTISM?

- Involvement in the local church (Acts 2:41-42).
- Continuing to live a new life in Christ (Romans 6:4).
